Intro: **C** – Arpeggio - count of 2

Arpeggio:

The rocks **C** and hills and streams cry out in **Em** in honor to His name.
The **A7** cattle on a thousand hills **Dm** assist me to proclaim
The **G** glory of creation but He **C** has no lips but **Am** mine
To **Dm** reach a soul, to tell him how to **G** know His love divine

Chorus:

Oh **C** let me live just one more day in **Em** service to my King
My **A7** pride I lay before His feet, a **Dm** broken heart I bring
Yet **G** happy, unbelieving, He could **C** use a one like **Am** I
A **Dm** slave of love, to share His shame, to **G** suffer and to die

De **A7** spising what I knew to be a **Dm** life of worldliness
Trans **G** form me by Your power now that **C** men might see in **Am** me

Chorus: Then Asus – A - D
