Find-it type 1 FIa_501 (for Hot Potatoes v 7) Michael Rottmeier's add-on

The examples in this tutorial are for version 5.0.1. You can easily adapt them for other versions (5.0.2 etc.)

I What is a Find-it type 1 exercise?

It's a JCloze exercice where the listener has to detect words (or phrases) in a text. These words can be correct words, extra-words or incorrect words.

As soon as the student detects the words, the correction is displayed, if necessary.

If you want the student to make the correction himself, use Find-it type 2 (FIb_501).

Examples (see the demo files):


- Find the adjectives in a text [FIa_501_demo0b.htm].
- Find the incorrect words in sentences [FIa_501_demo0a.htm and FIa_501_demo1.htm].
- Find the extra words which don't fit in with the sense of a text [FIa_501_demo_2.htm].

II What is new in the 5.0.1 version ?

- The version 3.1.4 has been updated for Hot Potatoes v7.0.
- As some customization items have been diverted from their original purposes by Michael Rottmeier, it can be difficult to know where and what to write in the customization windows. So special **interface files** has been written.
- In the original version when the listener had clicked on a word to be detected, the word was immediately replaced by the bolded correct word. Two others types of display have been added, with colors.
- The **feedbacks** have been modified .

III How do I install Find-it type 1?

Unzip Find_It_501a.zip and **copy the FIa_501 folder** where you want, for example in the source folder of Hot Potatoes.



<u>Note</u> : you can copy the folder anywhere on your hard disk and rename it as you like.

Verify that the demos, hif and source folders are present :



IV How do I create a Find-it type 1 exercise and HTML page ?I

The main things to keep in mind:

- In the main window of JCloze you enter your text as usual with the correct words.
- The incorrect word(s)^{*} which will appear in the exercice are defined in the "Gapped word alternatives" window.

* : the "incorrect" words are sometimes the same as the "correct" words [see demo0b or demo2]

• Before exporting an HTML page: **CTRL+ALT+SHIFT+S** to choose the source files of FIa_501.

V Load the interface file

You don't necessarily have to do it but if you load the interface file associated with Find-it it will be easier for you to create your exercise and change the configuration output.

Open JMatch. Click on **Options->Interface->Load interface file**.





This is the display used in the original version, though with no colors.





To modify them you need to open jcloze7.ht_ with a good text editor (not a word processor - use Notepad++, gedit or something decent like that).


You can add a comment **for a solution**; as soon as the word is found and the text box is shown a button [?] will be displayed which shows the comment.

This functionnality is optional.


