MICHAEL I want to go home, Dad.

TONY Yes, we are going home right now. So you explain what happened.. Thank you, Mr. Hill.

TEACHER Any time.

TONY Let's go/

They get up. They leave.

CONRAD'S OFFICE


Conrad and two goons sit at a table.
